

7 Scriptures to Bring You *Peace*



Isaiah 26:3 (CSB)

You will keep the mind that is dependent on you
in perfect peace,
for it is trusting in you.

Lord, I am focusing my mind on You, not my circumstances. I trust You to fill me with Your peace.

John 14:27 (NLT)

“I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don’t be troubled or afraid.

Oh Jesus, Your peace is a gift given to me! I accept it and receive Your peace in my heart!

1 Peter 5:7 (NIV)

Cast all your anxiety on Him because he cares for you.

Father God, I’m releasing all my anxieties to You, because You care for me!

Philippians 4:6-7 (CSB)

Don’t worry about anything, but in everything, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

Lord, Your Word tells me not to worry, but to pray with thanksgiving about everything. Then Your peace will guard my heart. I give all my worries to You, Lord God. Thank You for being my burden bearer.

Philippians 4:8 (CSB)

Finally brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable—if there is any moral excellence and if there is anything praiseworthy—dwell on these things

Dear Lord, There are so many circumstances that grab my mind and take my focus off You. Today, Lord God, I will think on what is true, pure, lovely and praiseworthy. And that is Jesus! My focus is on Him, not my circumstances!

Colossians 3:15 (NLT)

And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful.

Numbers 6:26 (AMP)

The Lord lift up His [approving] countenance upon you and give you peace (tranquility of heart and life continually).
